

Cordial Greetings...

COMMUNITY REFLECTION

Towards Silver Jubilee: Mission to the young -3

CONSECRATED LIFE IS OUR FIRST MISSION

My dear confreres and members of the Salesian Family, I feel that we are specially chosen by God through our Salesian vocation, and it is our bounden duty to live up to the call God has given to us. As we are entering into a new year, I just want to remind ourselves about the basics of our religious life that by living out our life of consecration to its letter and spirit, we fulfil our mission. Our Rector Major has given us the strenna 2023, "As the Yeast

in Today's Human Family - The Lay Dimension in the Family of Don Bosco." Though this is a call given to the Salesian Family members primarily, I consider it is more applicable to us Salesians.

There are some Salesians who are involved in the mission so much that they do not have time for their consecrated life and the practices of piety. Hence, I want to dwell on this topic, "Consecrated life is our first mission or Consecration itself is our mission." If we are not living well our consecrated life, I am sure our mission to the young will create no waves or vibrations. On the contrary if we enjoy living our consecrated life, there is no need to worry about our mission, because our exemplary life will speak for itself and there will be so many youngsters who will take on our mission and do it to the best. Hence, the basic question is, Do we enjoy living our consecrated life?

01. One confrere narrated his life and all his activities for about few hours during the visitation, finally giving it a punch, "I joined the Salesian congregation primarily to do social work and I am passionate about it." I was taken up by his words and much more by his emotional outburst. It is also true that he was working hard and greatly involving himself into many activities of various kinds for the empowerment of the poor and those at peripheries. But he was not regular for the practices of piety or showed any liking for the celebration of sacraments including the Holy Eucharist. I also realised that though the confrere was spending many hours in active ministry, the expected results were not achieved. There were problems of relationship among the members of the community. The issues related to the portfolios and the ego problems absorbed more time and there were no solutions to them at all. Professionalism took an upper hand over ministry and service-oriented approach. Hence, the results were not very positive.
02. In another community, I come to know that the members rarely come together for prayer, or the community had not seen all the members present in the mornings for prayer even for a few months. But the works go on and there are confreres who work day and night trying to do their best. Many initiatives are introduced, and several programmes are organized. Problems are solved and challenges are met. Many efforts are taken, and number of projects are executed. But the results are negative, and the confreres get discouraged. I don't need to describe the root cause. The community that is not united in prayer cannot move mountains. It is better that a confrere fulfils his prayer and religious duties first even without involving in any kind of mission than he gets involved in the mission so much forgetting his practices of piety and religious discipline.
03. It is not uncommon to see some of the confreres more worried about their portfolios and roles in administration than their vocation to religious life. Promotion seems to be their yardstick of measuring their growth in religious life. Becoming Rector or Headmaster is their goal and purpose of priestly life. These are expressions of

unhappiness in consecrated life or living the consecrated life to the minimum, fulfilling the rules and guidelines of religious life only. In such situations how can the mission flourish or our apostolate among the young see good results? A person who enjoys his vocation to religious life will go beyond the human considerations and rise above the problems of ordinary life. "Let nothing upset you," the maxim of Don Bosco will be his living rule. Doing the ordinary in an extra ordinary way will be his style of life.

04. Our constitutions are very clear in saying "the mission is entrusted to the community." Though our province is very good in carrying out the mission in communities and presences, there are a few confreres wanting to have their own way in accomplishing the mission. With the developments in media and novelty in ministries, they forget the basics of religious and consecrated life that they belong to the community and depend on the community for everything. I have heard of the statement that "the religious are individually poor but collectively rich and the diocesans are individually rich and collectively poor." But looking at the current scenario, I must conclude that there are some diocesans among the Salesians. I do not want to explain more details about this. I am sure all of you will be able to understand what I am referring to. Persons who enjoy their consecrated life will not be individualistic, but they will find happiness in community life and much more in the community moments of prayer and togetherness.


