# Congratulations to Bishop Elect Mgr. Lourdu Anandam - Sivagangai Diocese

Our Holy Father has appointed Rev. Fr. Lourdu Anandam (65), of the clergy of the Archdiocese of Madurai, currently the parish priest of the Holy Rosary Church and the Episcopal Vicar for religious of Madurai Archdiocese, as the third Bishop of Sivagangai. This provision was made public in Rome on 21 September 2023. Fr. Lourdu Anandam was born on 15 August 1958 in Thiruvarangam, in the Diocese of Sivagangai. He was ordained a priest on 06 April 1986 for the Archdiocese of



Madurai. On behalf of our province, we wish him all the best and support him with our prayers.

## 29th General Chapter (GC 29)

Our beloved Rector Major, Rev. Fr. Angel Fernandez Artime, has officially convoked the 29th General Chapter with the theme "Passionate for Jesus Christ, Dedicated to the Young -For a faithful and prophetic lived experience of our Salesian vocation". - Theme 2: Together as Salesians, Salesian Family, and Lay People 'With' and 'For' the Young.

- Theme 3: A courageous verification and redesigning of the Governance of the Congregation at all levels.

Let us continue to pray for the success of the Chapter so that we may receive the grace of God through the entire process of preparation and celebration of the Chapter.

## Provincial Visitation 2023 - 2024

The provincial visitation for 2023–2024 will begin in the second week of November 2023. The schedule will be announced in the middle of October. He has been assigned to go to Albania, Province of Southern Italy (IME). He will leave India on 13 October 2023 and continue his missionary journey to Albania. On behalf of all the confreres of our province, I pray and wish that he may enjoy good health, keep up his good spirits and contribute in the best way possible to enrich his missionary vocation.

# Approval for the New Presence - Kallikudi

Rev. Fr. Angel Fernandez Artime, our Rector Major, with the consent of the General

Council, has approved our request to make Kallikudi an independent presence. Don Bosco - Kallikudi presence will be a provincial level centre for faith formation (Christodayam), job placement and career guidance (Vazhikatti) and Vocation promotion.

The place will also serve the Catholic youth who aspire to write government examinations to work in the central and state government administrations. Since there is a well-known coaching centre close by, this building can give them accommodation facilities. There are other



reach-out services planned for the people of the locality too. They are; Government E-sevai Maiyam (to get all legal documents through online application), environmental education

and moral education in the neighbouring schools (Government Middle School, Vincent Matriculation School, etc) and evening tuition centres.

## Fr. Francis Sagaya Pinto - Definitive Transfer from INT to INM

Fr. Francis Sagaya Pinto, belonging to the Salesian province of Tiruchy, has been working at INM for the past few years on a temporary contract. He had requested the Rector Major for the definitive transfer from INT to INM. # TOWARDS SILVER JUBILEE - YEAR 3: SPIRITUALITY OF WITNESS LEADERSHIP IS BEING A WITNESS TODAY.

Everyone is talking about success in leadership in various terms, such as seven habits, ten commandments, essential aspects, etc. But I guess nothing can work except being a witness.

Everyone knows the theory of life—how good we must be and how effective our lives should be. There is no second thought about all these. What makes the difference is: who is the one who talks about these? Or who is the proponent of such tips and ideas? Meaning to say, how is his witnessing life and how is his



character? Is he human and loving? Does he do what he says? Hence, I feel that leadership is all about being a witness first and only then can he exercise leadership effectively.



I remember the days of my practical training as an assistant in the novitiate in Vellakinar, Coimbatore. My beloved novices are all doing very well today in both the provinces of INT and INM and others in the world. The timetable of the day used to start with a 10-minute exercise of running and doing some bodily movements. There were always some absentees for this first programme of the day. We can understand the laziness of everyone in this regard. Then I began leading the crowd and conducting the exercise myself. Every day we used to go in a different direction; otherwise, there were some wise novices who used to join the group only for the return journey. There were quiet gossips and murmurings here and there in the beginning, but everyone was present from then on, and gradually they also began to enjoy the exercise, after which my follow-up was not needed.

This is the reason why our Salesian presence plays a vital role in the formation of the candidates in our congregation. It is certainly not to limit or curtail the freedom of the individual, but to help or propose a model of doing things right. I have heard from many who are out in the world that the first and foremost thing they have found very helpful in their lives is the Salesian Presence. Now it is bringing rewards into their lives in the corporate world. All of us Salesians are leaders in one form or another in our daily lives. We need to be models and witnesses to the young in every aspect of our lives. There is no other secret to success in leadership.

I am grateful to God for the good leaders we have in our province. I must say most of our



houses are doing well because of the good leaders we have and their witnessing lives. But it is sad to note a few who expect much but who do not live much. I hope you understand what I am arriving at. Hence, as we are reflecting on the spirituality of witness, it is essential that all of us become witnesses.
