COMMUNITY REFLECTION

TOWARDS SILVER JUBILEE - YEAR 3: SPIRITUALITY OF WITNESS Living the Salesian Spirituality with Passion and Enthusiasm

As we go through the theme of General Chapter 29, we are reminded about our fundamental attachment to Jesus Christ, who has called us to follow him closely. I feel the new year 2024 is yet another opportunity for all of us to renew our commitment to the Lord and our fidelity to our vocation to holiness. As I go around the communities for visitation, I am reminding our communities and our confreres about the basics of our religious life, which is our spirituality and our identity. I had dealt with this theme during the visitation of the previous academic year. The question is, are we faithful to our spirituality, or are we

enjoying our spirituality? All those who enjoy Salesian spirituality, according to me, are certainly living a witnessing life, and they become motivators and inspirers for the present generation of young people. Let us further our thoughts on this theme in this circular.

I remember someone narrating the life of a young Salesian priest in Yercaud many years ago. I guess he is no longer in the congregation, but he lived a wonderful life as long as he was in the congregation. He was a very talented person, very much interested in young people and youth ministry. In fact, he used to animate the youth with passion and enthusiasm. He was sent for higher studies in media to the USA already in those years because he was very skilful and had the technical brains. Fr. Egidious Sola, who was the novice master in Yercaud for many years, became a confessor later in the post-novitiate. He used to always pull this young priest and make fun of him because he was not present for the morning prayer and meditation. He liked him very much because the young priest was witty and humorous. But I recall the words of Fr. Sola: "It's true that the young priest missed his morning prayer and meditation with the community sometimes, but I found him making the meditation later before lunch, and he always substituted the times he missed."

According to me, this is witnessing life. It's true that all of us are humans, and we are unable to be faithful to our prayer moments every day. But do we feel that we have missed our prayer? Are we making efforts to substitute the prayer that we have missed? If so, then we are certainly enjoying our spirituality, and this style of life will surely motivate and inspire the other confreres of the community and the young people as well. But what is happening in some of our communities is bothering me these days. There are some confreres including the rectors, who are absent for prayer moments. Some of them say that they are sick and taking medicines. Hence, they are not able to get up early in the morning for prayer moments. But these same confreres can get up early in the morning when they must travel to attend some functions elsewhere. They can get up when they must go for marketing. They happily rise in the morning when it is their turn for chaplaincy to go to the convent. There is no problem when guests are in the house. They can manage heavy schedules. They don't need reminders at all. The alarm works well and correctly.

What about community prayer and other practices of piety? Why are people frequently absent and make no efforts to substitute for the missed moments? Sometimes the brothers are always there for prayer, and the fathers take turns and are present now and then. Fortunately, there are not many communities like this, and not many confreres are absent. But still, one can bring down the spirit of the community, and as the Bible says, though the ninety-nine are good, we must go after the one that is lost.

The new year is a good time to renew ourselves and start all over again. We can give a new push and vigour to our spirituality and identity. Young people look up to us and we have to become witnesses of holiness to them. May this new year bring abundant blessings from the Lord and make us witnesses of spirituality. As we are marching towards the silver jubilee of our province, I invite all of us to work towards this ardent task of becoming

motivators and inspirers, especially for the young people who are entrusted to our care. As Don Bosco told Michael Rua when he was appointed as the Rector of Mirabello, "Be like Don Bosco in Mirabello," so too, let us become Don Bosco to everyone around us and in each of our communities. I am sure the charism of Don Bosco will reach far and wide through our witnessing lives. I pray for your all, for your good health and happiness all through the new year.
