# Career Guidance Seminar for XII Standard Students

The Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department (SC/ST) in Tamil Nadu organized a Career Guidance Seminar for XII standard students across all 38 districts of the state. The initiative, led by Ms. Priya Lakshmi IAS, Secretary for ADWD, and Mr. Anand Raj IAS, along with their team, was executed in collaboration with Don Bosco Vazhikaatti Trichy & Chennai, MMT, and Nurture Association in two phases. The first phase took place from April 22 to April 29, and the second phase from May 14 to May 21.

The Don Bosco Vazhikaatti (Trichy & Chennai) team participated in 9 districts during the first phase, including Trichy, Dindigul, Pudukkottai, Karur, Coimbatore, Salem, Namakkal, Tiruppur, and Tirupatur, and covered 37 districts in the second phase. During the first phase, the Don Bosco Vazhikaatti team engaged 3,045 students and in the second phase, guided around 7,000 students and parents in the Arts and Commerce stream. ## **COMMUNITY REFLECTION**

# TOWARDS SILVER JUBILEE - YEAR 3: SPIRITUALITY OF WITNESS NEW YEAR – NEW LIFE – NEW HOPE

My dear confreres,

We are stepping into another new academic year which is very special to all of us as we are preparing for the final celebrations of our Silver Jubilee. Let us be grateful to the Lord for his benevolence, our Blessed Mother for her guidance and our father and founder Don Bosco for his inspiration and charismatic vigour. As we are reflecting on the spirituality of witness in this year, let me remind you of the rich traditions of our congregation and the typical style of our province.

- 1. We belong to the Salesian Community and as members we should always exhibit a great sense of belonging and reverence to the community. Let us learn to live in holy joy.
- 2. The Rector is the animating centre of the community, and all the members should love and obey him even if we do not like him. He is the living Don Bosco in the community. All the members have the freedom to express their opinion, but the final decision is made by the Rector and all the members should abide by it.
- 3. Prayer life is the hallmark of the community. Absenting from prayer calls for serious examination and assessment. We should not be simply present for prayer but joyfully and happily enjoy the prayer moments of the community.
- 4. Community life is very precious to the members. Avoidance of community moments are symptoms of unhappiness, and it should be remedied at the earliest. We should enjoy the company of one another and make memories of our experience in the community.
- 5. The mission is entrusted to the community. Hence, all the members should work towards the best results, everyone contributing their might without counting the cost. The Rector should be the unifying force and when division arises, he should promptly deal with confreres who do not fall in line and set right the unity of the members.
- 6. Taking care of the elders and giving importance to the young Salesians are signs of blessing to the community. Let us not bypass these aspects. All of us have to go

- through these stages of life and the measure we give will be the measure we get back.
- 7. Lay partners are part and parcel of our community and the mission. They are not second-class citizens. Hence, respecting their role with dignity and loving them beyond limits are essential for smooth running of the community and the mission. The staff are to be given just salary and let us treat them with kindness and compassion.
- 8. Young people are our life. All our campus and space should be open to them. Let us welcome them with open arms and enjoy their presence. Guiding them and inspiring them are our characteristic traits and we should do them to the maximum.
- 9. A good assistant is one who observes everything, speaks little, and corrects the essentials. I remember well my classes on assistance in Yercaud. Let us be present to everyone, everywhere and always. Let us be angels of witness.
- 10. Let us breathe positivity. Negativity kills. Look at everything as an opportunity. Let us not be prophets of doom. Let us become a blessing to one another. We will never lack for anything. God will take care of us all the time.

There are many more aspects that I can mention but I guess few guidelines are better to remember and focus on our life. Let us do our best and God will take care of the rest. As I always share with you, we are not living with angels and saints in our communities. Everyone is ordinary human being with good and bad. We must put up with one another. And this should be done with great joy and happiness. As we are in the Jubilee mood, let us build up our province and take it to soaring heights. Let us imprint memories in the hearts of all the members. I am sure the new year will give us new life and new hope.
