COMMUNITY REFLECTION

SILVER JUBILEE OF THE PROVINCE OF TIRUCHY – WAY FORWARD Importance of Vocation Promotion

All of us are aware that the number of vocations is declining year by year. After the COVID, we have not regained our old numbers. This is a serious concern for our province and congregation. On the other hand, the number of vocations leaving the province continues to happen, and we have not been successful in controlling this either. Though numbers do not matter for the quality of our religious life, it matters a lot to continue our mission, or rather to extend our reach to other parts of the world where we have not reached so far. The interest in missionary vocation is increasing in our province, and that is the only

encouraging phenomenon in the recent past. Instead of conducting research on how and why the vocations are decreasing or leaving in the province, I would like to ponder some efforts and strategies to promote more vocations.

- **01. Following up Individual Candidates in our Parishes, Hostels and Institutions:** I am sure many of us came into the congregation at the invitation of some individual Salesians, like the vocation promotor or any other person who saw the seeds of vocation in us. The same should be continued by each of us Salesians in our respective presences. A candidate showing some interest in spirituality or youth work should be our target. We should show personal attention and care to that candidate and, at the appropriate time, extend a loving invitation to come and see our life or join the aspirantate and experience the joy of growing in religious vocation. This will surely reap a good harvest even if all do not persevere till the end. 'Each one catch one' should be our watchword.
- **02. Conducting Vocation Camp for all the XII std Catholic Students of our Schools:** We can conduct a summer camp for all the Catholic boys of all our schools during the summer, not calling it a vocation camp. The spirit of vocation camp should be there, and who knows, some of the candidates may be inspired those days and opt to join our congregation. By this, I do not mean that we must force every one of the students to attend the camp, but we can at least give them an experience of our life, and it does not matter if they do not opt to join us after the camp. Let them have the joy of making use of the summertime in the best way possible.
- 03. Rectors Meeting the Hostel Boys Individually once in a way to Motivate them and instil in them the Seeds of Vocation: The boys are very smart these days, and there are umpty number of distractions that keep them busy. Hence, we Salesians also should be smarter in doing our homework and creatively attract the boys to our congregation. The rectors meeting the boys individually at least once a term will certainly help in coming to know the interest of the boy, and this will give us an opportunity to invite him to join our congregation. Every opportunity is a God-given chance to promote vocations to our congregation. I am sure that following this method with seriousness and great interest will bring good results.
- **04.** Celebrating the Feast of Don Bosco in other Parishes and Institutions: We, the Salesians, have been mostly busy celebrating the feast of Don Bosco in our community, and we invite all the other religious and guests for the same. This is really good. But why don't we go out of our campuses now and then and celebrate the feast of Don Bosco elsewhere. I am sure there will be some parish priests who may be interested in giving us an opportunity of this sort. We could celebrate mass and give some pictures of Don Bosco or some souvenirs to all the people or even give them a good meal. I am sure the families will begin to talk about Don Bosco and the

Salesians from then on, and gradually there may be some good souls opting to join our congregation. Even if some candidates do not turn up, we can at least be satisfied with spreading the name of Don Bosco far and wide.

- **05.** Erecting some Monuments of Don Bosco in other Parishes and Institutions: All of us are aware of youth groups in several parishes named after Don Bosco. It will be good to offer them a statue or even erect a grotto or a bust of Don Bosco in those places and spread the devotion to Don Bosco. Frequent visits to such places and celebrating masses and novenas to Don Bosco will surely help in promoting vocations to our congregation. We will be erecting a monument to Don Bosco in St. Xavier's ITI and Don Bosco Press in Thanjavur, and we are grateful to the Provincial of Mumbai, who has accepted to sponsor the same. I feel we should be ready to spend any amount of money for such works, which will eventually promote vocations.
- **06. Beginning a Magazine like Don Bosco's Madonna in our Province:** Don Bosco was a man for the times, and amidst all the works, he was a publisher and a writer. We should follow and interpret him to our own times. There is already a magazine in Tamil, 'Salesian Seithi Malar.' We could perhaps circulate this in a big way in our province or start another smaller magazine that need not be even printed but circulated digitally to all the parents and children of our schools and parishes so that they come to know all our works. I am certain that this effort will create some sensation, and there will be candidates motivated to join us in the future. Who knows, there may be some good souls who may become our benefactors too.
- **07. Vocation Promotion Commission and Zonal Vocation Promotors:** We will be having a commission for vocation promotion from this academic year, and there will be zonal vocation promoters appointed who will work in collaboration with the Vocation promotor of the province. We realize that one person is unable to be present in the parishes at the stipulated time, and so these zonal vocation promotors will be able to substitute the vocation promotor. I am sure this strategy will be helpful in contacting many parishes and candidates who are interested in joining our congregation. Personal follow-up will also be there, which will gradually increase our popularity among the region, and many more candidates will come to know about Don Bosco and our charism.
- **08. Vocation Day in all our Parishes and Institutions:** I exhort all our presences to seriously plan this vocation day and make sure all the students experience a memorable day. Giving them all a book, a picture, or some souvenir will be a good gesture. Let's go back to the traditions our missionaries followed in their times for promoting vocations. Every effort that we undertake will be a great investment in vocation promotion.

My dear Confreres, I have given a few suggestions for vocation promotion. There could be many more innovative ideas in your minds. Let's all join hands together and work hard in this area of promoting vocations to our congregation. The results do not matter, but our efforts matter a lot in this endeavour. God will surely reward our hard work and send many more vocations to our congregation. Let's move forward with faith and hope.
