

Dissemination of Strenna 2026

The Strenna 2026, presented by the Rector Major, Fr. Fabio Attard, is entitled: "Do whatever He tells you: Believers, free to serve." This annual theme serves as a spiritual and pastoral compass for the entire Salesian Family. It is deeply rooted in the Gospel of John (2:5), specifically the Wedding at Cana. It emphasizes that faith is not a duty, but an encounter. In a world often marked by "digital bubbles" and a search for transcendence, the Salesian Family is challenged to be credible witnesses. The Strenna reminds us that Mary does not just command obedience; she invites a proactive, loving trust in Christ that leads to true freedom and service to those most in need.



The dissemination of the Strenna will be held for all the leaders of our communities on Saturday, January 17, 2026, at Don Bosco Provincial House, Kallukuzhy. Subsequently, the leaders will organize a day of animation on the Strenna within their respective Salesian presences, inviting all members of the Salesian Family and young people from the neighbourhood to participate before February 15, 2026. To foster a greater sense of fraternity and sharing, nearby communities are encouraged to consider holding the Strenna presentation together.

Annual Retreat

COMMUNITY REFLECTION

'TOGETHER AS PILGRIMS TO REJUVENATE SALESIAN LIFE AND MISSION' was the motto that I propose to the province, the Salesian Family and the lay mission partners, for the coming 6 years. Let me explain to you a little, in order to grasp the basic dynamism in the motto.

TOGETHER: For the last nine years we concentrated on the theme COMMUNION among us. We need not sit back and say that we have achieved communion to its perfection. Communion is a process, that progresses, but never ends. Though we grow in perfection, there will be some imperfections which can be rectified during the process. Hence, the word TOGETHER denotes the communion among the Salesians, the Salesian Family Members and the Lay Mission Partners. To substantiate togetherness, go through the following readings: Jn 15:1-12 and C.12,16.

PILGRIMS: Church is on a pilgrimage towards realizing the Kingdom of God, here on earth. The popes were insisting on this word during the jubilee year (2025) of the church. We the Salesian Family Members are also on a journey (pilgrimage), together with the Catholic Church, in realizing the Kingdom of God in our lives and in the lives of young people. Remember, pilgrimage is also a process, but has a clear goal of reaching God. In this pilgrimage we don't walk alone, but together as a vast movement of persons, people set apart for the salvation of the young. C.5

REJUVENATE: Our Church and the Congregation are calling us constantly to renew our life and mission. Renewal is a character which is very unique to young people. They always look for new avenues. We, Salesians, who are always with the young, 24 hours, should have the same spirit of renewal in us. Hence, I'm calling everyone to rejuvenate, particularly in our life as Salesians and in our mission for the young. Col 3:5-16

SALESIAN LIFE: Among the various crises that we face today in our religious life, the predominant one is the Identity Crisis. Who am I? is a question that is not answered for a very long time, sometime even till the end of our life on earth. At times we know our identity theoretically, but hesitate to live it in our day-to-day life. That we are Salesians, we are Religious, we are priests, consecrated by God for His mission is our identity. Hence, we are invited to live our Salesian Consecrated Identity in its fullness. C.3

SALESIAN MISSION: We are happy to belong to the Salesian Congregation, within the Salesian Family, a vast movement of dedicated persons, because our mission focus is very clear. We are evangelizers of the young, who keep worrying about saving their souls for God, all the time. Give me souls and take away the rest is the Mantra, composed by our father and founder St. John Bosco, which keeps ringing in our hearts 24/7. Salesian Province of Tiruchy, has gone ahead further in defining the focus as reaching out the most marginalized young people who are the poorest. Their cry echoes in our hearts every-day.
